Parkland is an affluent, 14.3 mile city located in the northern-most part of Broward County; drawing crowds from the tri-county area—Broward, Palm Beach, and Miami-Dade County. The Farmers' Market brings approximately 4,000 people each date, and has continually grown each year.

Along with a vast assortment of produce and organic products, the City of Parkland Farmers' Market includes a variety of baked goods, coffee and tea, pet supplies, sauces, seafood, treats to enjoy while walking the market, activities for kids, and more.

The market also hosts Specialty Market days as an extension of the regular market. The Craft Fair will feature local artisans with handmade goods, paintings, gifts, home décor, and apparel. Health and Wellness Day includes things like fitness, essential oils, medical offices, and active lifestyle brands. Bring your well behaved and leashed furry friend to the Pet Expo to discover natural pet foods, treats, and pet accessories.

Our Community Awareness market welcomes Parkland based nonprofit organizations to showcase their mission as well as Parkland's Emergency Services with safety education and vehicle displays. Finally, the Environmental Expo will celebrate Arbor Day with plant giveaways and focus on recycling and sustainability.

Parking is conveniently located and may be available behind booth spaces when possible. Vendor set up begins at 6:00am on Market days and staff will be on site to assist and direct you to your assigned booth space.

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REQUIRED PERMITS/LICENSES

ALL VENDOR PERMITS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. Submit copies of documents to farmersmarket@cityofparkland.org or mail to:

All Vendors are responsible for collecting their own sales tax.

FARMERS/GROWERS

- Grower's Permit issued by the Agricultural Extension Office in the county where the crops are grown and listing the items grown on the permit.

PRODUCE/PLANT RESELLERS

- No Permit Required

BAKED GOODS/CONFECTIONS/BEVERAGES/GOURMET/PROCESSED FOODS

- FDACS Permit (unless it falls under the Cottage Food Law)

RESTAURANT/CAFÉ

- DBPR License

SEAFOOD/DAIRY/MEAT/POULTRY

- FDACS Permit

PLANTS/TREES/ORCHIDS/EXOTICS/FLOWERS

- FDACS Division of Plant Industry License

DÉCOR/CRAFTS/ART

- No Permit Required



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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Returning Vendor application will be accepted beginning April 6th. New vendor applications will be accepted startingJune 1, 2023. All applications will be reviewed by the City of Parkland and the Parks and Recreation Coordinator has the full authority to approve or deny participation in the Market.
- 2. If you apply online, please select your preferred payment method on the application and wait to hear from us for payment instructions. Payment will be due within one (1) week, upon acceptance into the market.
- 3. APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE: Up to three images of items sold, including one of the booth display. Returning vendors are not required to submit photos. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- 4. Mail completed applications along with a copy of permits/licenses and pictures (if applicable) to:

FEES AND PAYMENT

<u>A booth assignment for the season will not be guaranteed until payment is made in full.</u> Fees must be paid before 5:00pm on the due date or booth spaces will be forfeited. Once payment has been made, the City of Parkland does not offer refunds. Row placement and assignment will be completed by the Parks and Recreation Coordinator and is subject to change, specific booth placement will not be guaranteed as it will be a first come fist serve basis.

* Full Season - Payment will be due in full within one (1) week, upon acceptance into the market.

Farmer/Grower \$225 per 10x10 space

Other \$400 (Resident) / \$480 (Non Resident) 10x10 space

*\$25 off for Parkland based businesses with a valid Local Business Tax Receipt.

Discount good for full season only.

* Daily / Specialty Vendor - Payment will be due in full within one (1) week, upon acceptance into the market and at least 48 hours prior to market..

Other \$65 per 10x10 space
